

Wu Jinglian Education Fund

Start from 2008, Prof. Wu Jinglian, Bao Steel Chair Professor of Economics, CEIBS Senior Research Fellow, Development Research Centre of the State Council of P.R.C. Member, set up a fund in his name (Wu Jinglian Management Education Fund) to support the first-year MBA students.

Number of Winners:

- 2 scholarships of RMB80,000 each

Candidates:

All Candidates who have been admitted to the CEIBS MBA Programme.

Approaches to Application Review:

CEIBS MBA Admission Committee is composed of Deans, one permanent faculty member, Directors of MBA Programme, Director of Career Development Center, MBA Admissions Managers and MBA Programme Manager. The selection of Wu Jinglian scholarship winner is merit and need based. The committee members will review candidate application and decide the winner list based on the following:

- Academic background (university, degree, GPA, etc.)
- Working background (managerial experience/potentials, international exposure, etc.)
- Score of admission test (GMAT, CEIBS Admission Test, interview score, etc.)
- Honor and/or award, community, extracurricular and professional activities, etc.
- Corporate sponsorship, etc.

The Committee may invite the candidates for an interview and ask for further certifications, references and any other information deemed relevant if necessary.

Awarding of the Scholarship:

The scholarship will be awarded in two phases.

In the first phase, the first half scholarship will be granted in the form of tuition discount.

In the second phase, the second half will be granted when the MBA Office have grades from the first two terms. Whether a scholarship holder actually gets the second half or not will depend on his or her performance on campus, including academic performance, participation in community and campus activities, contributions to CEIBS and compliance with school regulations. Should the accumulative GPA in the first two terms be below the class average, the school would cancel the second half of the scholarship (Student will not be required to

refund the first half of the scholarship). Under such circumstances, the second half of the scholarship will be awarded to another student who has outstanding academic performance and community contribution but has not received CEIBS scholarship before.

Rights and Responsibilities:

1. Rights:

Scholarship winners will be awarded the scholarship certificate at the opening ceremony.

2. Responsibilities:

- a) Scholarship recipient should offer his or her service to CEIBS with no additional remuneration. This obligation will be an average of 3 hours per week for Wu Jinglian scholarship recipients. Duties will be assigned by the MBA Office and may involve service within any relevant department of CEIBS. Were he or she unable to perform his or her duty, he or she should make explanations to the MBA Office or other departments and ask for exemptions from his or her duty. Should he or she be absent from the specified services for twice (and without any prior leave request), the school would have the right to cancel the second half of the scholarship and even ask for return of the first half.

- b) Scholarship recipients should act as role models both on campus and off campus regarding personal ethics, academic performance and community activities. Were there any of his or her behavior in serious violation of school disciplines and regulations, or even against the law, the school would cancel his or her scholarship and ask for the full refund.

Other issues:

If a scholarship recipient has to leave CEIBS for any reasons (expulsion, voluntary departure, etc.), CEIBS has the right to ask for full refund of the scholarship.
