Cathay Capital will donate €500,000 to CEIBS to establish the Cathay Global PE Research Fund, which aims to promote the study of trends, cases and risk-reward models of global PE investment, as well as innovation in the industry, organisational structure and management patterns in the new economic environment. The donation ceremony took place at the Beijing Campus on August 28.

Innovation, Transformation & Management Incentives

Internet age at the “CEIBS 2015 Thinking and Innovation Forum” in Guangzhou on November 10. Banyan Capital Partner Gao Xiang (EMBA 2009) and eHi Car Services Cai Lihong later joined Prof Chen for a roundtable discussion. And “How Payroll of Senior Management Could be Tailor-Made” was the topic of a lecture by Professor of Accounting Hwang Yuhchang at a Management Forum in Nanchang on November 18. Volvo China's Drive Me China campaign placed second, a marketing campaign from Nissan took third place, and Dongfang Infinity's Dare to Love campaign received an award for being voted Most Creative.

Beijing Campus Anniversary Forums

The development trends of China's film industry, disruptive innovation, the joy of music, and China's "One Belt, One Road" initiative were the focus of discussions at four anniversary forums organised recently by the CEIBS Beijing Campus. Founder and Chairman of Bona Films Yu Dong spoke at a forum on October 24, while CEIBS Associate Dean (Executive Education) and Prof of Marketing Wang Gao led November 1 discussions on disruptive innovation with ZUK co-founder Chen

Well Done!

The school's Management Committee announced the winners of the 2015 Research Excellence & Teaching Excellence Awards in August. Professor of Operations and Supply Chain Management Zhao Xiande was awarded the 2015 CEIBS Research Excellence Award. Professor of Accounting Hwang Yuhchang, Professor of Economics Zhu Tian and Adjunct Professor of Management Jeffrey Sampler were awarded the 2015 Teaching Excellence Awards. The first CEIBS Medal for Research Excellence was awarded to Professor of Finance and Accounting Oliver Rui in September.

The exemplary research being done by CEIBS faculty also received recognition recently from a host of globally renowned institutions. A paper co-authored by Prof Zhao won the Jack Meredith Best Paper Award given by the *Journal of Operations Management*. The paper is titled "The impact of supply chain integration on performance: A contingency and configuration approach". A paper co-authored by Professor of Strategy George Yip and Visiting Professor of International Business Bruce McKern was chosen by the editorial team of the *International Journal of Emerging Markets* as a Highly Commended Paper of 2014. Papers by Professor of Organisational Behaviour and Human Resources Management Tae-Yeol Kim and Professor

of Economics Bala Ramasamy received this year's prestigious Emerald Citation of Excellence in recognition of their high number of citations and their content. The paper co-authored by Prof Kim is titled "Cognitive Team Diversity and Individual Team Member Creativity: A Cross-level Interaction" and was published in the *Academy of Management Journal*. The paper co-authored by Prof Ramasamy is titled "China's Outward Foreign Direct Investment: Location Choice and Firm Ownership" and it was published in the *Journal of World Business*.

Parkland Chair Professor of Strategy Sam Park was recognised by the Academy of Management (AOM) for his work on emerging markets, naming him the recipient of the IM Division Outstanding Service to the Global Community Award. The award was given to Prof Park during the AOM's annual meeting in Vancouver in August. A seven member delegation of CEIBS faculty, including Prof Park, attended the AOM meeting.

Meanwhile, the case study titled "Hotelvp: Swimming with Sharks" written by Assistant Professor of Entrepreneurship Gong Yan, Professor of Entrepreneurship S Ramakrishna Velamuri and researchers Dr Liman Zhao and Doris Dong was judged to be among the top 10 best case studies submitted to the CEEMAN Case Writing Competition 2015.



EMBA & FMBA 2013 Graduate

For the first time ever the EMBA and FMBA Programmes held a joint graduation ceremony, with participants from Beijing and Shenzhen joining their classmates in Shanghai to celebrate this grand milestone on October 31. To commemorate their graduation, the six EMBA 2013 classes and two FMBA 2013 classes invested RMB850,000 in the school in a donation ceremony held at the Shanghai Campus on October 15. The class names will be inscribed on pillars and stone stools at the Shanghai Campus.

CEIBS Board Chairman Honoured

CEIBS Board Chairman Prof Zhang Jie is the recipient of the 2015 Edward Teller Award from the American Nuclear Society. It is the highest prize in the Nuclear Fusion field and it is the first time a Chinese scientist has received such recognition. President of Shanghai Jiaotong University and an academician at the Chinese Academy of Sciences, Prof Zhang Jie has made significant contributions to the study of the generation and propagation of hot electrons

in laser plasma relevant to inert confinement fusion and the reproduction of astrophysics processes.

CEIBS' Newest Chair Professors

The appointment of four new chair professors was announced on November 1. They are Zhongkun Group Chair Professor in Finance, Oliver Rui; Philips Chair Professor in Strategy and International Business, Klaus Meyer; Zhu Xiaoming Chair Professor in Accounting, Chen Shimin; Wu Jinglian Chair Professor in Economics, Xu Bin. The appointments reflect

the outstanding achievements of these faculty members in research, teaching and service to the institution.

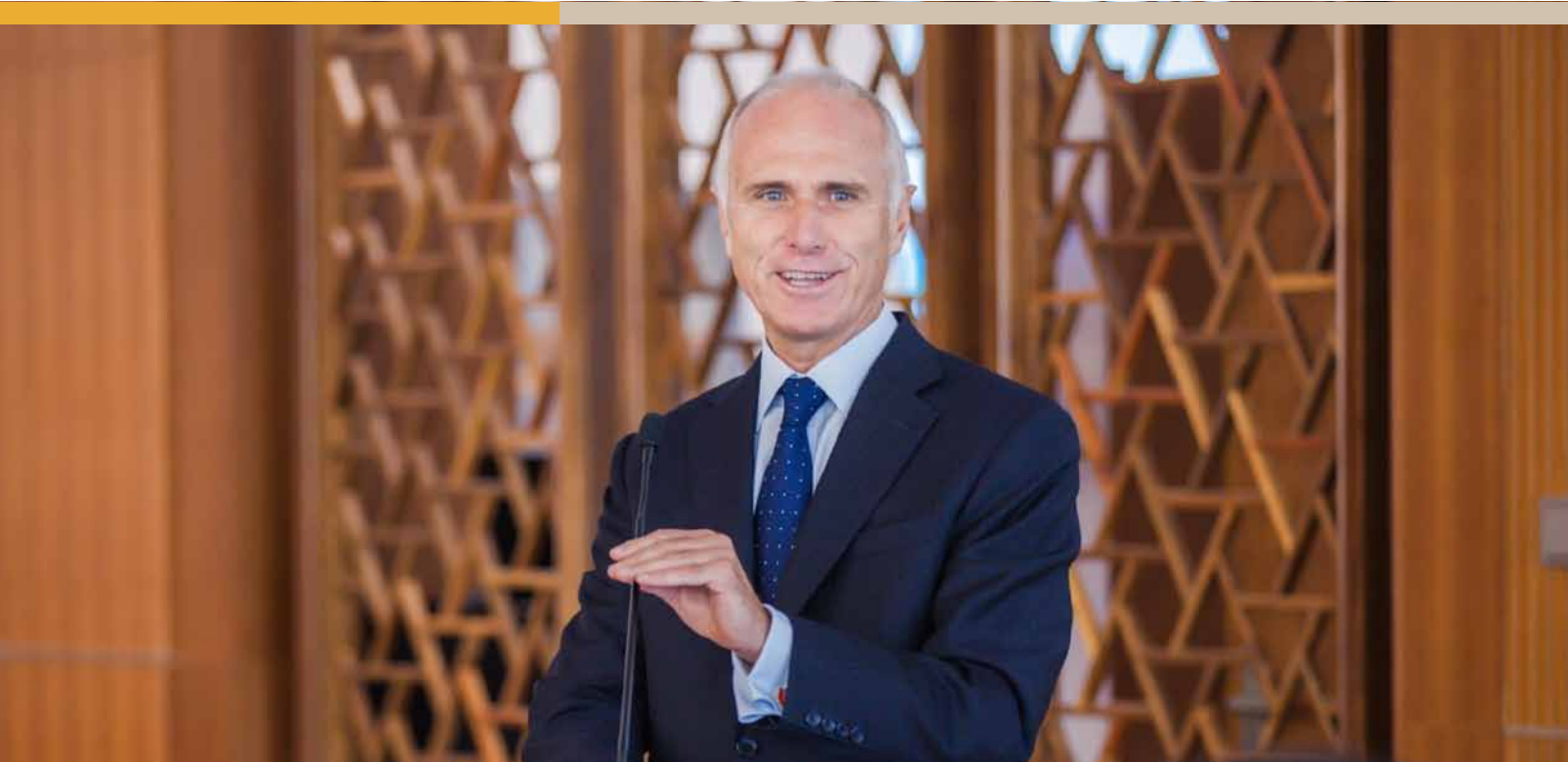
opportunity to meet with renowned Chinese entrepreneurs such as Duan Yongping.
